- 5 Hawks Bay Sparkling Wine NV** **Glass £5.50/£28.00**
This wine is produced in the Champagne Methode, using the three noble grapes Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier & Chardonnay. The palate is fresh and lively exhibiting classic fruit flavours. One to Celebrate.
- 6 Hawks Bay 2002 Black Label Sparkling Wine** **£40.00**
The new vintage is always eagerly awaited and the 2002 was certainly worth waiting for. A Pinot Meunier dominant, "typical", Champagne blend. Made for Champagne connoisseurs and "bubbly" people alike.

- 9 Morton Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2009/10 – New Zealand** **£12.00**
For Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, this wine shows those lovely hints of Passion fruit, Citrus and capsicum.

Rose Wine

- 13 Hawkes Bay Musetta Rose 2007** **£20.00**
This is a sassy blend of Merlot with Melbec. Nice red berry fruits and a sophisticated character.

White Wines

- 16 Marlborough White Label Sauvignon Blanc 2010** **£21.00**
One of James Hallidays top 60 New Zealand Wines. 2010 was a fantastic year For Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, this wine shows those lovely hints of Passion fruit, Citrus and capsicum.
- 17 Hawks Bay Pinot Grigio 2008** **£22.00**
This is proper Pinot Grigio, left on the vine a little longer before harvest, the cool Nights and warm days of the region enhance the varietal complexities of white pear, Nectarine, quinces and Cut hay. I challenge you to find a better example of this varietal.
- 18 Hawks Bay Viognier 2007/08** **£30.00**
This Gold Medal Winner from the Mercedes Benz wine awards shows all the wonderful characteristics of Viognier. Aromatic orange blossom and Mandarin are support the wonderful aromas of ripe apricot. This "new kid on the block" is one to try.
- 19 Hawks Bay Black Label Chardonnay 2004/05** **£35.00**
This is the Estates Flagship wine; the richness of colour indicates the intenseness of flavour within, a smokiness on the nose with a hint of vanilla combines with the Citrus palate and is a pure delight to drink.

Red Wines

- 35 Hawks Bay White Label Hawks Bay Syrah 2007/08** **£22.00**
The palate is weighty and smooth, with lovely soft, ripe tannins providing length and Stature. Spicy prunes dominate the flavours, perhaps with a delicate sprinkling of black pepper.
- 36 Hawks Bay Mercure 2007/08** **£25.00**
A superb artistic fusion of the Bordeaux Varietals Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Malbec. Aromas of Dark plum, Cassis, mint, cigar box and Sandalwood creates intrigue and induces conversation.
- 37 Hawks Bay Black Label Pinot Noir 2007** **£36.00**
Fruit of exceptional ripeness and flavour was harvested from the famous Stone Creek Vineyard in Marlborough, Aromas of Black Cherries, with underlying black Doris plums. A silky palate envelopes the palate like a silky sheet. Poetry in a bottle!
- 38 Hawks Bay Regent 2004** **£45.00**
The name sake of this wine was another prominent red James Douglas - The Regent of Morton. A masterful Bordeaux style blend that portrays all the style of a great leader - Nobility and softness (Merlot), powerful leadership (Cabernet Sauvignon), combined with strong backbone and guidance (Cabernet Franc). Certainly a wine to savour.
- 39 Hawks Bay White Label Pinot Noir 2007** **£26.00**
Lifted aromas of mocha chocolate, boysenberry and raspberry complement an intense black doris plum character while underlying hints of maraschino cherries are evident. The palate is silky and medium bodied with a lengthy fine-grained tannin finish.

ROSÉ WINES

- 13 **Hawkes Bay Musetta Rose 2007/08 – New Zealand** £20.00
This is a sassy blend of Merlot with Melbec. Nice red berry fruits and a sophisticated character.
- 14 **Madfish Sangiovese Rose 2010 – Australia** £25.00
The bouquet is full of raspberry, cherry and spice aromas. The palate is fresh and lively with intense varietal raspberry and cherry fruit expression and a clean crisp dry finish.
- 15 **Cotes du Provence Rose Reserve du Chateau St Baillon 2010 – France** £30.00
A classic Provencal rose, beautifully pale in colour and renowned as the peoples favourite rose.

WHITE WINES

- 20 **House White Alto Bajo Sauvignon Blanc – Chile** Glass £3.00/£18.00
Refreshing acidity and attractive balance, this wine is also elegant, round, and mouthfilling.
- 27 **Ca'Marengo Pinot Grigio della Venezie IGT 2010 – Italy** Glass £3.00/£18.00
Light and easy-drinking style, with hints of pear and almonds, and a zesty, refreshing finish.
- 21 **Agustinos Chardonnay Reserva Privada BioBio Valley 2011-Chile** £22.00
Bright fresh fruit with subtle notes of vanilla. Elegant with good acidity and well blended creamy character and a very soft finish.
- 22 **Knappstein Handpicked Riesling 2010 – Australia** £28.00
Knappstein is one of the biggest names in the Clare Valley, perhaps Australia's most enigmatic wine region. Classic Riesling from Clare.
- 23 **Alisios do Seival Pinot Grigio/Riesling Campanha 2010 – Brazil** £20.00
Yellow greenish in colour this is a ripe, explosive Pinot Grigio followed an amazing textural palate with a mineral twist from the Riesling on the finish, to lift it up and refresh the mouth.
- 24 **Sancerre Blanc Le Manoir Andre Neveu 2010 – France** £39.00
Pale green/gold. Herbaceous, citrus nose with a hint of apple. Fuller and richer on the palate than the nose would suggest. Almost a tropical fruit flavour with a zingy minerality and freshness.
- 25 **Petit Chablis Patrick Piuze 2010 – France** £36.00
Great value from vineyards just outside the Les Clos Grand Cru appellation. Fresh, steely and attractive.
- 26 **Blue Slate Riesling Mosel Dr Loosen 2010 – Germany** £25.00
Very fresh and aromatic with floral, grape and peach on the nose. The off-dry palate has more of the same but cuts the sweetness with a wave of refreshing lemon and lime acidity.
- 28 **Jvbilm Sicilia Pinot Grigio/Zibibbo 2009/10 – Italy** £23.00
This has a perfumed, chalky, orange peel, rose petal and Turkish Delight character here – you can't complain about provision of aroma here! It has the same open character on the palate, with a soft richness, rather plump overall although there is some nice acidity hidden beneath.
- 29 **Riva Leone Gavi 2010 – Italy** £25.00
Delicate with intense fruity & lemony notes. Clean and fresh with a long lingering citrus finish.
- 30 **Saam Mountain Paarl Chenin Blanc 2010 – South Africa** £21.00
Rich tropical aromas of pear, guava and ripe yellow stone fruits jump out of the glass. The abundance of flavours carry through onto the well-structured palate.
- 31 **Journeys End "Haystack" Chardonnay 2010 – South Africa** £30.00
Located in Stellenbosch, with vineyards adjacent to Vergelegen and Morgenster. The ripeness of the fruit fleshes out the palate; the creamy taste combines well with the lime acidity and gives freshness, lifting and lengthening the flavours.

RED WINES

- 40 House Red Alto Bajo Cabernet Sauvignon - Chile** **Glass £3.00/£18.00**
Ripe red cherries and blackberries. This Cabernet Sauvignon is medium-bodied and fruit forward, with ripe, well structured tannins and boasts a satisfying and lingering finish.
- 41 Valdivieso Reserve Merlot 2008/09 – Chile** **£27.00**
Dark intense red. Rich dark cheery aromas, typical Chilean Merlot profile. On the palate full and flavoursome, with ripe fruit flavours and well integrated oak spices.
- 42 Valdivieso Eclat 2007 – Chile** **£35.00**
Dark intense red with distinct violet notes towards the edges. Complex spice, red fruits & slightly wild aromas. A well structured wine, being full bodied, lots of flavour & vibrant refreshing acidity.
- 43 Catena Malbec 2008 – Argentina** **£32.00**
Smooth-textured, layered, rich wine bordering on opulence...it has an elegant, light-on-its-feet personality. On the palate, spice notes and a hint of chocolate emerge.' Wine Advocate 91pts
- 45 d'Arenberg The Dead Arm Shiraz 2007– Australia** **£65.00**
d'Arenberg's flagship is the 2006 The Dead Arm Shiraz. Opaque purple-colored, the nose is reticent but gives up aromas of meat, bacon, game, truffles, blueberry, and blackberry. Firm, layered, and complex, this beautifully rendered Shiraz demands a decade of cellaring.
- 46 Brouilly Vieilles Vignes Chateau Moulin Favre 2010 – France** **£28.00**
Light, juicy and fresh with lots of pick-you-own strawberry and raspberry fruit and crisp acidity. The tannins are light and delicate with just enough oomph to carry the fruit along to the finish.
- 47 Chateau Lugagnac Bordeaux Superieur 2008 – France** **£30.00**
It is a stylish, complex, full-bodied wine with well defined berry/plum fruit aromas and flavours and integrated spicy oak. Well. The wine is full bodied, silky soft and richly textured 50% Merlot, 50% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 49 Villa dei Fiori Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2010 – Italy** **£20.00**
Ripe, rounded, slightly rustic Italian red combining spicy black olives with morello cherry notes and a refreshing acidity. A wine full of fresh and classic Italian characteristics.
- 50 Ceppaiano Alle Viole 2007 – Italy** **£28.00**
Deep ruby colour with garnet reflections. Creamy mouth feel with gentle acidity, dark fruits, aniseed and orange peel. Typical, intense and vibrant wine from the sandy soil of the Tuscan Tyrrhenian coast.
- 51 Saam Mountain Heldersig Pinotage 2010 – South Africa** **£26.00**
Deep purple Pinotage with a typical plummy and black berry nose. The intensity of the fruit is carried onto the palate where it fills one's mouth with juicy tannins and ripe, dark, fruit with hints of vanilla. The aftertaste is long, fruity and very elegant.
- 52 Solarena Barrel-Aged Tempranillo DO Carinena 2009 – Spain** **£19.00**
Solarena is ripe in character with spiced raspberry aromas. The enticing brambly fruit on the palate gives way to rounded, velvety, vanilla flavours, while the subtle oak adds extra richness, structure and intensity of flavour.
- 53 Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Crianza 2007 – Spain** **£38.00**
Intense cherry red, this wine has aromas of parma violets and red fruit, vanilla and spice. This is a wine with a concentration of red fruit flavours from the ripe Tempranillo as well as well integrated spice, vanilla and a light 'toastiness', for a long, elegant finish.
- 54 Delicato Family Vineyards Old Vine Zinfandel 2008 – USA** **£25.00**
Rich fruit flavours of blackberry jam and spice. Full-bodied with black cherry, vanilla and pepper notes and ripe, soft tannins. U.S. Winery of the Year in 2006, 2002 and 2001- International Wine & Spirit Competition American Winery of the Year 2007
